BIO

Born 1995 in LA and raised in San Diego, Dylan began playing music in school band. A multi-instrumentalist, Dylan started on oboe in 6th grade, then learned to play bass guitar, guitar, ukulele, mellophone/french horn, trumpet, low brass, upright bass, baritone guitar, mandolin, viola da gamba, vocals, etc.. Dylan studied briefly with San Diego Bassist Gunnar Biggs before earning Bachelor’s of Arts in Music at UC Irvine. Conservatory faculty Dylan studied with includes Jazz Program Director & pianist Kei Akagi, Jazz Bassist Darek Oles (Oleskiewicz), Gerry Pinter, Bobby Rodriguez, Michael Dessen, Christopher Dobrian, and, Jason Harnell.

In college, Dylan would busk by the coast in a brass band called *I Plead the Funk*, and gig around SoCal for public, private, university, and corporate events with classmates and colleagues, playing jazz, orchestral, and popular music. Dylan also worked as a luthier (repair tech) at the San Diego County Music Exchange in Vista CA during undergrad. After graduating, Dylan and Katie (Dylan’s wife and an environmental scientist at UC Davis), moved north to Santa Rosa CA, and now both work and teach in Northern California.
