They were tutored by legendary San Diego bassist, Gunnar Biggs, before proceeding to earn a Bachelor's of Arts in Music at UC Irvine. Conservatory faculty Dylan worked with included Jazz Program Director and visionary pianist Kei Akagi, famed Jazz Bassist Darek Oleskiewicz, and world-class music professors including Kojiro Umezaki, Christopher Dobrian, Bobby Rodriguez, Michael Dessen, Gerry Pinter, Jason Harnell, Nicole Mitchell, Amy Bauer, and Lukas Ligeti. During undergrad, Dylan often played at the Newport Beach pier with a brass band called I Plead the Funk, and gigged around LA and Orange County for private, university, and corporate events with pickup bands, or their college Jazz quartet, The Jazz Cats. Dylan also worked as a luthier (string instrument repair technician) at the San Diego County Music Exchange in Vista CA during and for several years after their undergraduate studies. After graduating, Dylan and (now wife) Katie, decided to move to North Bay (Santa Rosa) after visiting and enjoying the area.
