After daydreaming in grade school piano lessons, Dylan started music seriously on oboe in the 6th grade, then added bass guitar, guitar ukulele, mellophone, french horn, trumpet, tuba, euphonium, upright bass, baritone guitar, and mandolin to their repertoire. They trained under renowned San Diego bassist Gunnar Biggs before earning a Bachelor's of Arts in Music at UC Irvine. Dylan also worked as a luthier at the San Diego County Music Exchange in Vista CA during and for several years after their undergraduate studies.
